On November 7, 1997, Air Canada Cargo made a very special delivery to London Zoo. In a specially designed crate, Emmet, an almost 2000-kg. Asian elephant, was lifted from the van used to truck him to Pearson International Airport by a special forklift and loaded into the hold of an Air Canada B-747 Combi.

Together, the elephant and the crate - which measured 419 cm. long, 168 cm. wide and 259

cm. high - weighed in at 2,041 kgs. Then, Air Canada Cargo flew Emmet and his two handlers 3000 miles to London/Heathrow, where he was safely delivered to the folks from London Zoo.

Thanks to the careful planning of the journey, Emmet's biggest concern was how many of his favorite jelly beans remained during his ride to his new home.
